- 5. Contact no., e-mail and full address of the bidder must be clearly mentioned in E.O.I/RFP/RFP. proposal.
- 6. In the event of any complaint regarding after sales service and in case of supply of defective/substandard material, the selected firm shall have to rectify the defects within a period of 15 days. The firm must have a service centre with qualified technical staff in the state.
